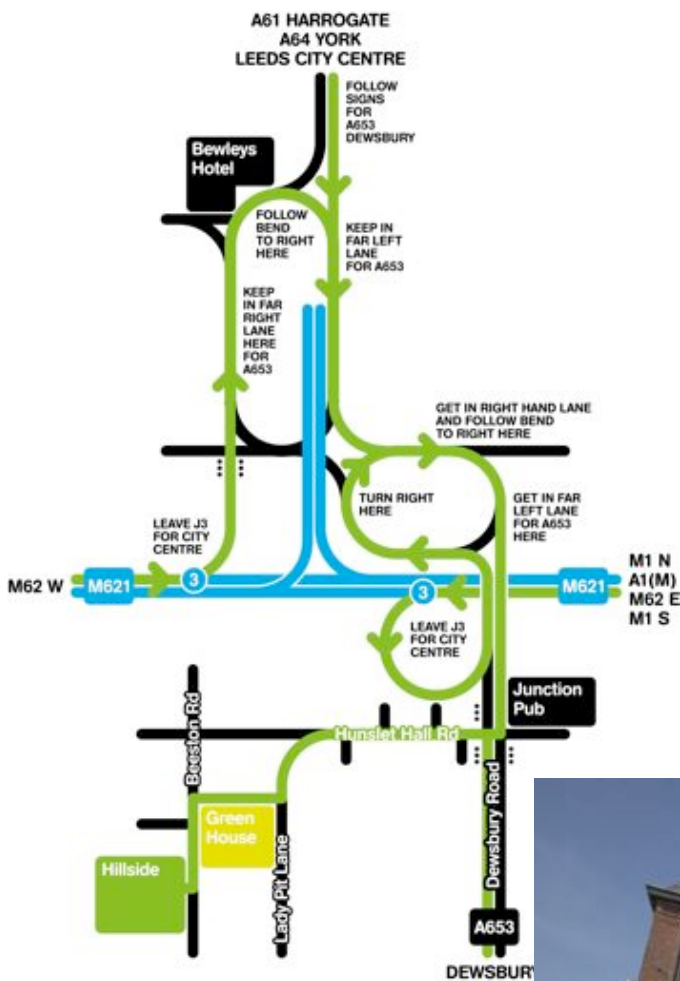


## Directions to Hillside



### By road

Hillside is just one mile south of Leeds city centre

It is well linked to both the M1 and M62 motorways being just five minutes from junction 3 of the M621 (see map)

Hillside is opposite the Greenhouse – a large white and green building with wind turbines on the roof.

Free parking is available to the front and rear of the building and on surrounding streets.

### By Bus

The number **1** bus runs every ten minutes between Hillside, Leeds city centre (railway station) and Headingley.

The **86** bus links Hillside to Middleton and Bramley.

The following busses run along Dewsbury Road: **2, 3, 76, 117, 202, 203, 220, 221, 481.**

The **64** and **74** busses run to the junction of Beeston Road and Tempest Road.

## ***Directions to Hillside***

### ***By Car from Leeds city centre west***

From the inner ring road (A58M) head west to the Armley Gyratory System, get into left hand lane. Follow signs “The West, Halifax, Huddersfield” and fork left after going under railway bridge, signposted to “Holbeck” and “Halifax Huddersfield”. Turn right at the roundabout and get into left hand lane. Proceed straight ahead at next roundabout (first exit) onto Domestic Street under the viaduct. Bear right onto Top Moor Side at the mini roundabout (second exit). Turn right onto Cemetery Road and cross the motorway bridge. Turn first left onto Malvern Road, proceed crossing the mini roundabout and turn next left onto Beeston Road. Hillside is the Victorian building on your left.

### ***By Car from Leeds city centre east***

Leave the Loop at the junction of The Calls and Briggate, turning left and crossing Leeds Bridge. Go forward on Meadow Lane towards M621.

- Stay in left hand lane following signs to “A653 Dewsbury”. The road bends to the left, move into the right hand lane. The road bends right and crosses a bridge over the motorway. Continue to traffic lights with Junction pub on your left and the old Police Station on your right. Turn right onto Hunslet Hall Road at the traffic lights. When the road bends left, fork right (signposted “Sports Centre”). At T junction turn left onto Beeston Road. Hillside is the Victorian building on your right, opposite the Greenhouse flats.

### ***By car from the west M62***

Leave the M62 at Junction 27 signposted “M621 Leeds Centre”. Leave the M621 at Junction 2, taking the third exit from the roundabout signposted “A643 Morley”. Fork left immediately on leaving the roundabout onto Elland Road, turn right at the T junction onto Cemetery Road. Turn first left onto Malvern Road, proceed crossing the mini roundabout and turn next left onto Beeston Road. Hillside is the Victorian building on your left.

### ***By car from the south M1***

After Junction 42 for M62, stay in right hand lanes signposted “M621 Leeds Centre”.  
◆ Continue on M621 to Junction 2A signposted “Beeston Holbeck”. At the end of the slip road turn left onto Cemetery Road. Turn first left onto Malvern Road, proceed crossing the mini roundabout and turn next left onto Beeston Road. Hillside is the Victorian building on your left.

### ***By car from the north M1***

Leave the M1 at Junction 44 and follow the signs to the M621.

## Parking at Hillside

In addition to the 14 visitor spaces to the front of the building, there is ample free parking located on Beeston Road and around the building. Please refer to the diagram below.
